FROM THE PASTOR

CHANGE

The operative word in this common January greeting is *new*. There is no doubt that there will be *new* things in 2024.

Normally we welcome *new* things. We do not exchange used gifts at Christmas or any other celebratory event like birthdays, anniversaries, graduations, baptisms, or retirement. *New* implies, however, *different* from what we have known. 
